- Continue as a full-time student in an accredited two- or four-year college or university beginning Fall 2026.
- Scholarship funds are to be applied only towards school expenses for the upcoming school year beginning Fall 2026-2027 and may not be applied to past costs.
- Unused scholarship awards shall be returned to Lahaina Restoration Foundation.
- Children, grandchildren, brothers or sisters of employees or board members of Lahaina Restoration Foundation are ineligible to apply for the LRF scholarship.

**Completed application must be mailed in a 9 x 12 envelope to Lahaina Restoration Foundation Scholarship, PO Box 294, Puunene, HI 96784. Applications must be postmarked no later than March 20, 2026. Application must include:**

1. This cover sheet
2. Essay – 250 -500 words, double spaced
3. Transcript (unofficial)
