2. The village was situated above an ancient volcanic crater surrounded by two large mounds. The Japanese immigrants referred to the village as "Maruyama" (round mountain). The mounds were excavated for cinders so the mounds are no longer round.

3. Additional information has been added (October 2011) from records gathered by Lahaina Restoration Foundation and Kaunoa Senior Services from previous residents that attended Lahaina Plantation Days in 2009 and 2010.
