
Lower Mahinahina

- 2. Lower Mahinahina Camp was part of the Pioneer Mill sugar cane community. Most if not all of the men in the camp formed a "konpan" group to irrigate and care for many acres of sugar cane in a profit sharing co-op arrangement with PMCo.
- 3. Pedro Lesponia served like a camp boss. In the early years, his house had the only refrigerator and telephone and movies were shown on his premises.
- 4. This camp was abandoned in July 1953.
