- Scholarship awards apply to tuition expenses for 2026-2027 school year beginning the Fall of 2026.
- Unused scholarships shall be returned to the Lahaina Restoration Foundation.
- Children, grandchildren, brothers or sisters of employees or board members of Lahaina Restoration Foundation are ineligible to apply for the LRF scholarship.
