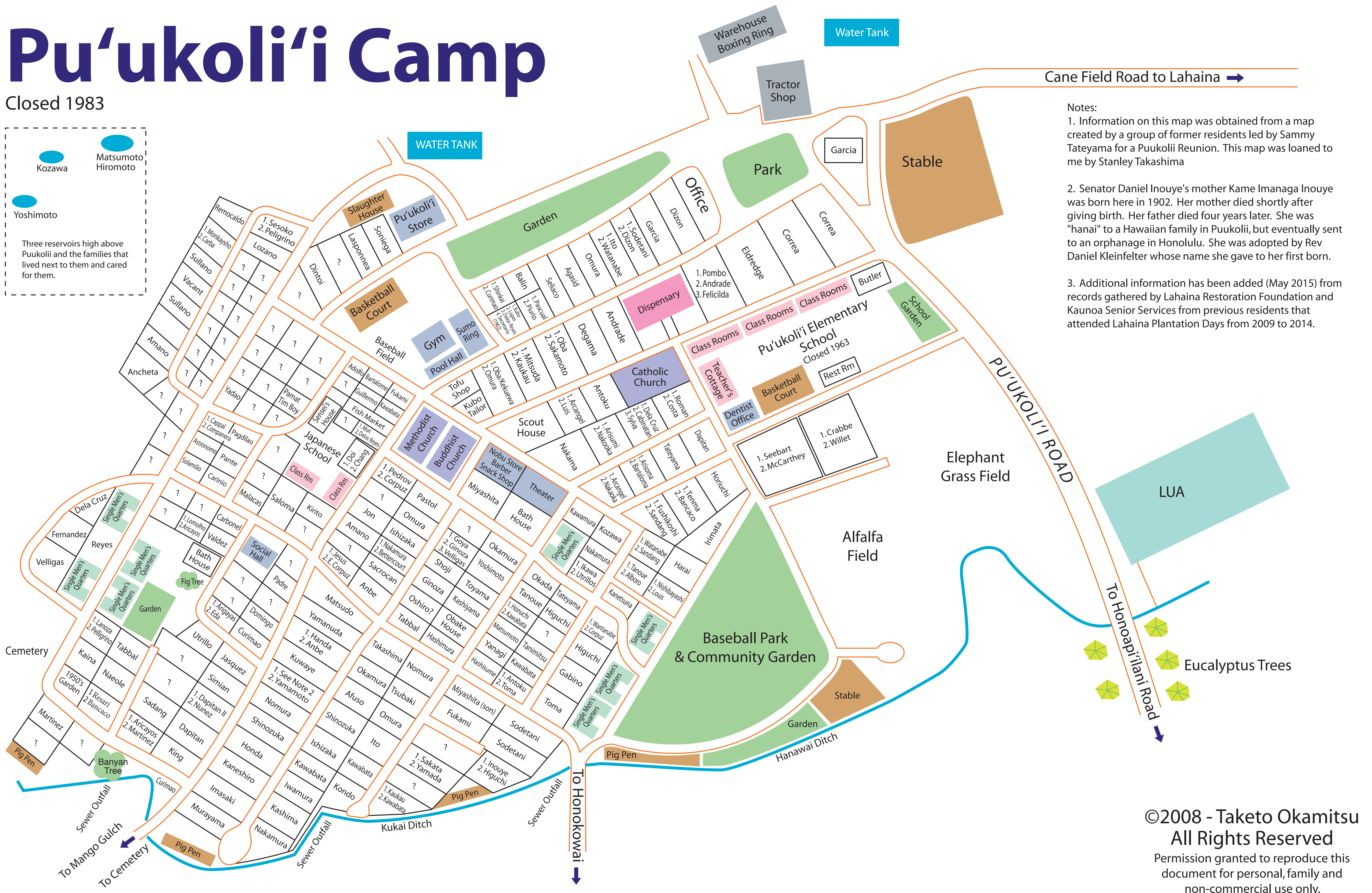


Pu'ukoli'i Camp

- Senator Daniel Inouye's mother Kame Imanaga Inouye was born here in 1902. Her mother died shortly after giving birth. Her father died four years later. She was "hanai" to a Hawaiian family in Puukolii, but eventually sent to an orphanage in Honolulu. She was adopted by Rev Daniel Kleinfelter whose name she gave to her first born.
- Additional information has been added (May 2015) from records gathered by Lahaina Restoration Foundation and Kaunoa Senior Services from previous residents that attended Lahaina Plantation Days from 2009 to 2014.
