- Be an alumnus of Lahainaluna High School.
- Continue as a full-time student in an accredited two- or four-year college or university beginning Fall 2023.
- Scholarship funds are to be applied only towards school expenses for the upcoming school year beginning Fall 2023-2024 and may not be applied to past costs.
- Unused scholarship awards shall be returned to Lahaina Restoration Foundation.
- Children, grandchildren, brothers or sisters of employees or board members of Lahaina Restoration Foundation are ineligible to apply for the LRF scholarship.

Completed application must be emailed to LRF office at events@lahainarestoration.org **no later than midnight March 10, 2023.** The LRF Scholarship Committee will select the recipients. Awarded scholarship checks will be made out and sent to each recipient's designated college or university.
